

**EMERGENCY INSTRUCTIONS**

**Counseling and Psychological Services**

If assistance is needed during evening or weekend hours, emergency help is available. Counseling and Psychological Services staff can be reached *for* emergencies by calling (313) 123-1234 outside of regular office hours. Wayne State University Police Department is also available in emergencies (dial 577- 7911).

Provides voluntary and involuntary evaluation. WSU Police Department will transport students exhibiting potentially harmful behavior.

Provides outpatient adult psychological services, testing and a special program *for* victims of crime and their families. The services are fee-based.

Provides immediate assessment, phone intake, and referral to appropriate placement. Sliding fee scale based on the ability to pay. Staffed by psychiatrists, psychiatric residents, and social workers.

Individual psychotherapy, drug treatment, and counseling are available.

Crisis line, assessment of situation and referral *to* facility appropriate to the individual. Suicide counseling, information, and referral source *for* individuals needing food and shelter.
