

THE ROBERT OSWALD CORK SCHOLARSHIP

The Robert Oswald Cork Scholarship is an endowment for students with disabilities in undergraduate and graduate programs. Eligibility includes: be a Wayne State University Student with a disability and registered with Educational Accessibility Services; attend full-time for semesters recipient receives the scholarship; and have at least 3.0 overall GPA, completed application, most recent transcript and written statement. Eligible applications are reviewed by Educational Accessibility Services Scholarship Committee. Awards are determined for two recipients who are notified in late spring.

The Robert Oswald Cork Scholarship

Eligibility Requirements:

You must be a Wayne State University student with a disability and registered with Educational Accessibility Services (EAS).

Attend full-time for the semesters you receive a scholarship.

Have at least 3.0 overall GPA.

Information that your application MUST include:

1. **Most recent unofficial transcript.**
2. **Attached detailed explanation of your circumstances including:**
 - **your disability**
 - **encountered barriers**
 - **financial need**
 - **accomplishments**
 - **personal and career goals**
 - **participation in disability related issues**

Type or print clearly all information.

Illegible or incomplete information may result in denial of review.
