

## **WAYNE STATE UNIVERSITY HANDICAP PARKING INFORMATION**

**In order to qualify for WSU Handicap Parking, you, the student must have a State of Michigan issued handicap mirror tag or plate registered in your name. You must also be registered for a WSU's current semester class or classes.**

**In order to have parking on the first day of classes you are responsible to do your part by getting your parking assignment completed prior to the start of a semester. The parking office requires 72 hours in order to follow through with paperwork and to activate your OneCard.**

**The SDS office needs a copy of the following items prior to issuing handicap parking.**

- 1.) Proof that you have an issued State of Michigan handicap parking tag or plate that is current.**
- 2.) A copy of your current Official Class Schedule from WSU Pipeline.**
- 3.) WSU issued identification card (One Card) with PID number.**
- 4.) Payments may be made with: a personal check, money order, vouchers or a Visa or Master Card, made payable to Wayne State University. This office does not accept CASH.**

**If you lose your WSU hanging tag, there is a fee for a replacement tag is \$10.00. Be advised that it is very important that you have this tag hanging on your mirror at all times, in front of your State of Michigan mirror tag. Non-compliance may result in being issued a ticket in which you are solely responsible for.**

**Parking is to be renewed at the beginning of each semester. You will receive a renewal form in the mail from the Department of Parking and Transportation Services prior to the beginning of the following semester. In order to renew your parking assignment, bring that form along with a current official class schedule to the SDS. Refunds, nor credit is given for missed days.**

**You will be allowed to park in designated "staff" areas of the university parking structures and lots. (See the Map for locations.) Please be sure to use a handicap parking spot.**

**Please be aware that you are to use your handicap parking on your assigned day/s only. The One Cards are activated for those days and will not work in the assigned lots at any other time. If you want to use the student structures, at your own expense, make sure you add money onto your One Card for that purpose or you may choose to add a specified day onto your parking assignment at the time of activating your assignment. There is an additional cost of \$36.00 per day, per semester.**
